It is best to get your school uniform at the end of the Summer holidays to get the best fit for your child, for September.

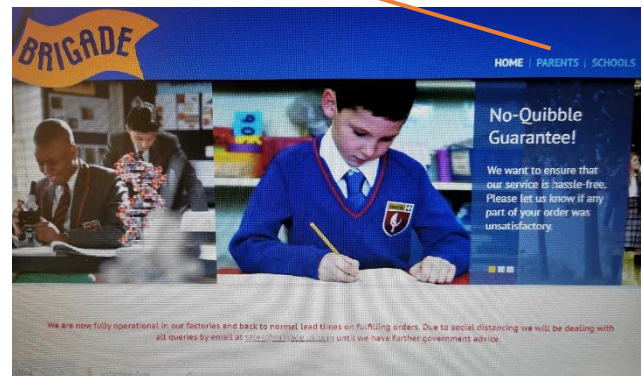
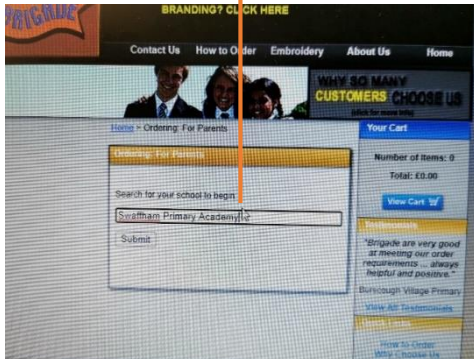


You can visit the website Brigade to buy school uniform.

First, on the homepage, click on the tab that says 'Parents' at the top right.

You will then be directed to a page where you can type in our school, Swaffham Primary Academy and that will take you to our uniform selection and logo.



You will need:

- A purple school jumper or cardigan with our **Logo** on.
- White/purple polo shirts or white shirt/blouse. We recommend purchasing 3. As well as from Brigade, you can purchase these in most local supermarkets.
- Grey/black trousers, grey/black skirt/pinafore or a purple check summer dress.
- A pair of wellies that can stay at school for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.
- Smart school shoes
- A named water bottle.
- A purple book bag for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.
- A backpack is optional for Y3 onwards.

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Our School Logo

We do ask that your child's **school jumper or cardigan has our logo on**. This gives us all a real sense of pride in our school and the wonderful community we belong to. It is also able to ensure that your child is quickly identifiable as part of our group, on school trips or visits. PE Kit

Your child will need:

- A T shirt that is the colour of their 'House'. House colours are red, green, blue and white. You will be told your child's House Colour.
- A pair of black or grey shorts
- Comfortable, named trainers
- A named bag for their PE Kit.
- A tracksuit for colder weather.



Reception and Key Stage 1

Your child will *not* need a backpack in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. In their book bag we can fit any letters and their reading book. They can carry their water bottle to our water station in class and their wellies can live on our welly rack. We will have a space to store any lunch boxes.

Key Stage 2

Your child can now bring a backpack to school, if you choose.
