Come Fly With Me - Africa



English

The children will be learning how to write a mystery story that is based in Egypt and finding a treasure within a forgotten tomb. They will then create a set of instructions explaining how the Ancient Egyptians would mummify people. Finally, the children will be looking at the story of Tutankhamun and will discover that Howard Carter lived in Swaffham. The pupils will write persuasive letters to the local council about having a memorial for Howard Carter in the town.

PE

Children will be learning about and performing gymnastic based routines and then move onto dance in the new year. These are Thursdays and children are to come in their PE kit that day.

Science

We will be studying Animals including humans: investigating nutrition from what we eat, skeleton and muscles. Connected to our new unit, Come Fly with Me - Africa, the children will be finding out about the Big Five animals!

In Year 3, we are so excited to start our second of four units this year. This is a culture unit, entitled 'Come Fly With Me - Africa.' The river Nile played a major role in the development of Ancient Egypt and the children will be exploring rivers to help understand its impact. We are really looking forward to art in this unit as we are working with an artist who will be visiting the children in January to work with them to create some amazing Egyptian inspired artwork.
