Dear Families,

There have been some really cold mornings this week. Our Site Manager, Mr Webb is on site from 6am to check site safety. This includes putting grit down on pathways and checking all routeways are useable. Sometimes we then shut off a path and re-route the children. We did this today with our Little Terns class. Well done Little Terns! We also made the decision not to hold our usual morning Celebration Worship as it was too cold for the children to walk across the school. Thank you for sending your child to school in a cosy coat, hat and gloves. It is that time of year again where we are likely to have some lost property so please do your best to name your child's items and talk to your child about taking care of their belongings such as gloves and hats.

Next week we are expecting the next set of contractors on our site to install the outdoor play equipment for our Early Years area- part of our nursery development. We have planned this to avoid disruption to the running of our school. The contractors will arrive after the start of our school day and aim to leave around 4pm. This means that they will be here as parents and carers are collecting children at the end of the school day. The contractors will be based near our Trim Trail. They will have heras fencing around their compound/ work area. The work is being carried out in blocks to avoid causing an area of congestion where families in Year 1 and Reception are collecting children. The work will start Monday and should be completed by the end of the week. Thank you for your patience whilst this work is being carried out. We are very excited about this next phase and the provision that is being installed.

Another very exciting development is that our stage went up on Thursday in readiness for Nativity 2025- 'A Miracle in Town.' Details of our Nativity Performances have been shared with families in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 on Dojo with a Google Form to complete.
