It was wonderful to accompany Miss Sleet on Wednesday evening to attend the Children and Young People Strategic Alliance Flourish Awards where she had been selected as a finalist for the Learning Award. The Award Ceremony took place at The Assembly House in Norwich. Over 650 nominations were made for 8 categories with the judges selecting 3 finalists per category. The other 2 finalists in The Learning Category were: St Nicholas Priory CE VA Primary School and The Lighthouse- a trauma- informed, attachment based independent school.

The award ceremony was very prestigious with leaders in Norfolk County Council there and guests from lots of agencies that work with young children and families.
